CERTIFICATION IN PERFORMANCE-BASED eLEARNING WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Workshop Description

This workshop defines “e-learning” as any training that is delivered electronically when the facilitator and the participants are not in the same location.

This is a self-paced workshop in which you will receive any amount of individual attention that you need. You will develop and demonstrate the skills necessary to create effective e-learning by going beyond just putting instructional materials in an electronic format.

Who Should Attend?

This workshop is for instructional designers that need to develop or revise training materials that will be delivered through e-learning.

Pre-Requisites

This workshop does not teach instructional design, so the participants must have already completed CRI and IMD or have completed another course in developing performance-based training.

You must bring a performance-based lesson to the workshop that has not been delivered through e-learning. (Performance-based lessons contain a performance objective, contain relevant practice and feedback, and require a skill check for completion.)

How Long Is this Training?

This is a self-paced workshop. It may take up to three full days to complete.

What Will You Receive?

- A workshop binder containing all of the instructional modules
- A CD containing the worksheets and job aids from the workshop

Requirements for the Certification

In addition to completing this workshop, you will be required to forward a complete e-learning lesson that you have created, along with a participant evaluation of the delivery of that lesson.

What Will You Learn to Do?

Upon completion of the certification process, you will have demonstrated the following skills:

- Evaluating e-learning effectiveness
- Selecting the most appropriate e-learning delivery system
- Using an e-learning delivery system that he/she will use most often
- Troubleshooting that e-learning delivery system

- Explaining the delivery system and troubleshooting procedures to participants
- Identifying job aids and how to access them after training
- Organizing the content and graphics for e-learning lessons
- Adapting or creating lesson materials to perform skill checks and practice with feedback through e-learning
- Encouraging participant progress and completion
- Explaining communication with the facilitator and with other participants
